## MEMORABLE EVENTS, FUTURE AND PAST

### **FUTURE: *The Holocaust Cantata***

A reminder that you are invited to join with our Jewish community at Temple Jeremiah at 4:00 p.m. on Sunday, February 19th to hear the Holocaust Cantata: Songs from the Camps, performed by the Vesper Chorale of Musical Arts Indiana, South Bend. This event is being co-sponsored by Am Yisrael Congregation, Temple Jeremiah and our church, and funded by our church's Simple Gifts Concert series. It will be preceded by a short presentation by Ms. Magda Brown, a Holocaust survivor. We are recommending advance ticket purchase by calling 1-877-323-8801; tickets are \$20 (\$15 for seniors and students).

Also, I thought you might be interested in the following informative and touching paragraphs from a news release on the Holocaust Cantata, written by Cantor Stuart Simon of Am Yisrael Congregation:

"In 2008, to commemorate the 60th anniversary of Kristallnacht: Night of Broken Glass, which marked the beginning of widespread and systematic persecution of the Jews, the board of the Kurt and Tessye Simon Fund for Holocaust Remembrance approached Vesper Chorale about performing the Holocaust Cantata. Vesper Chorale was requested because of the chorale's commitment to performing sacred music from many traditions. It was an association that was, to use a Yiddish expression, "b'shert" or meant to be; it is the collaboration between a Christian choir and a Jewish community that WNIT-TV sought to portray.

"Stories of the Holocaust are embedded in the Jewish community. Still, the depth of feeling a Christian choir, grappling with this difficult material, most for the first time, brought to the music made the experience profoundly powerful to both performer and audience, to both Christian and Jew."

**PAST: *The First Annual GCC GCC (Great Chili Cook-off)*** What fellowship and fun last Sunday evening as we filled the Mayflower

room to taste and consume chili prepared in the crock-pots of 11 GCC chefs. And it was a highly successful fundraiser for our Pilgrim Youth Fellowship, who provided music, a continuous slide presentation of its activities, salad, condiments, and drinks, and even its own chili entry. Pam and I entered "Heavenly Chili," which I modified from a Chicago Tribune recipe for Hodgepodge Chili. As several have requested, here's the new recipe:

- Preparation time 35 minutes; cooking time 3 hours; yield 10 servings
- 1 tbsp vegetable or olive oil
  - 1 lb each of Italian sausage and ground beef
  - 1 large onion, chopped
  - 1 green bell pepper, chopped
  - 4 cloves garlic, minced (Used minced garlic from a jar.)
  - 2 jalapeno peppers, chopped (Watch your eyes!)
  - 1 tbsp each of chili powder and cumin seed
  - ¼ tsp salt
  - 1 can (28 oz) diced tomatoes, undrained
  - 1 can (15 oz) kidney beans, undrained (A second can of undrained kidney beans may be used)
  - 1 can (6 oz) tomato paste
  - ¼ cup each of chopped parsley and cilantro
- Optional toppings: shredded cheese, chopped onions, sour cream or plain yogurt
1. Heat oil in a Dutch oven over medium heat, and add sausage and ground beef and brown them. Stir in onion, bell pepper, garlic, jalapenos, chili powder, cumin seed and salt. Stir often until onion softens, then
  2. Add and combine tomatoes, beans, tomato paste, parsley and cilantro. Heat to a boil and reduce to a simmer (partially covered) for 2½ to 3 hours. Add more chili powder if needed.

This must be a "first" for the Broadcaster—a chili recipe on the minister's page. Enjoy!

**HOP Israel/Palestine Trip Presentation**

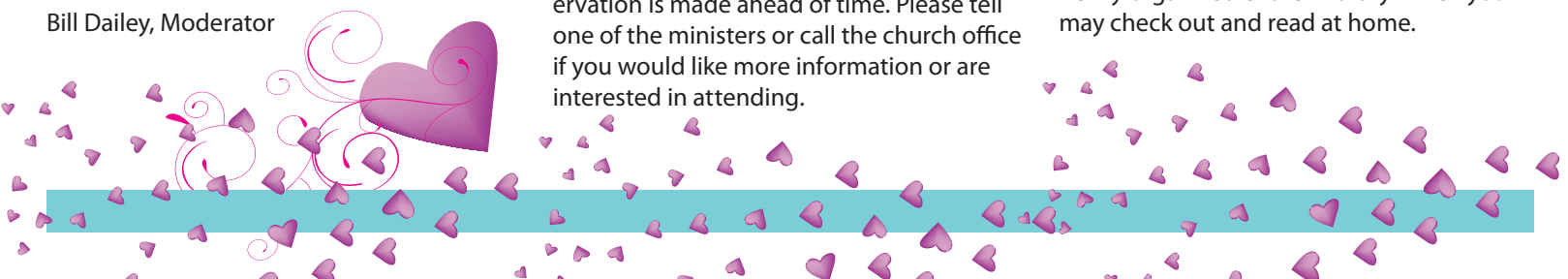

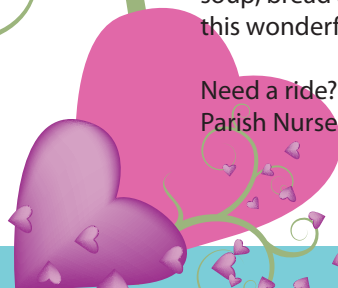
